**TROPHY TO 1<sup>ST</sup> PLACE WINNERS**

CLASS A – UP TO 6,500 LBS. 56 P.T.O. H.P. MFG. EST. LIMIT (NO TURBOS)

NOTE: CLASS A – 6,500 LBS. 1955 AND OLDER – MUST BE COUNTY TRACTORS ONLY

1956 AND NEWER TRACTORS OPEN FROM ANYWHERE

CLASS B – UP TO 8,500 LBS. - - - 73 P.T.O. H.P. MFG. EST. LIMIT (No Turbo)

CLASS C – UP TO 10,500 LBS. - - - 86 P.T.O. H.P. MFG. EST. LIMIT (Turbo inlet no larger than 1.63")

CLASS D – UP TO 13,500 LBS. - -NO HORSE POWER LIMIT (No Turbo)

CLASS F – UP TO 17,000 LBS. - - - NO HORSE POWER LIMIT (Turbo inlet no larger than 2:31)

CLASS G – UP TO 20,000 LBS. - - - 195 P.T.O. H.P. MFG. EST. LIMIT (open to 2- or 4WD)

- 1) Stock RPM's in all Farm Classes. Throttles will be checked at weigh-in. Do not over-fuel injection pumps. No Cut tires in any class. No add-on H.P. boost of any kind injected into engine. 18:4:38 tire width and height limit in Classes A-B-C. .  
Class A through F open to 2-wheel drive tractors – stock block  
Class B tractors with add-on turbos must pull in Class C  
Class C tractors with add-on turbos must pull in Class F  
Non-turbo Class C tractors can weigh up to 11,000 lbs.  
2400 RPM limit for any Class C tractor  
2600 RPM limit for any Class D and F tractor  
Puller will be responsible for removing hose to check turbo inlet size  
1.63-inch max turbo inlet on all Class C tractors. No reduced sleeves in turbo inlets.  
2.31-inch max turbo inlet on all Class F-G tractors. No reduced sleeves in turbo inlets.  
No S-3 Switzer turbos allowed in any turbo class.
- 2) 18-inch drawbar limit in Classes A-B-C  
20-inch drawbar limit in Classes D-F  
21-inch drawbar limit in Class G

***PULLERS INC. TRACTORS CAN WEIGH 11,000 LBS MAX***

**TROPHY TO 1<sup>st</sup> PLACE WINNERS**

1. 640 cubic inch limit.
2. 3000 maximum freeload RPM (Top 3 tractors checked at end of track).
3. Turbo Charger limit:
  - a.) 2.80 inch measured inlet maximum
  - b.) No Big Foot chargers
  - c.) No S-3 Switzer Turbos allowed
  - d.) Exhaust manifold mounting must be equivalent to IH 400 Series, JD 55 Series, or equivalent mounting for other brands.
4. Stock exhaust manifold mounting except for models that have to change because of turbo charger rule.
5. Fuel booster pumps allowed.
6. Water injection pumps allowed.
  - a.) Tractors must have empty water tank prior to drivers meeting.
  - b.) Tank can be filled from a sealed bottle (such as distilled water or water from pull site) after drivers meeting in the presence of an official of that Pull.
7. Tires
  - a.) No cut tires allowed.
  - b.) 20.8 maximum tire size—for PULLERS INC TRACTORS only.
8. Slipper Clutches not allowed.
9. Sheet metal
  - a.) Sheet metal must stay the same as chassis number.
  - b.) No side shields unless factory equipped.
  - c.) Must be stock block for model of tractor.
10. Safety equipment—PULLERS INC TRACTORS
  - a.) Fire extinguisher.
  - b.) Wheelie bars.
  - c.) Air shut off.
  - d.) Dead Mans Throttle (optional). (If not equipped with Dead Man's Throttle you must also have a second air shut off from driver's seat.)
  - e.) Cross-bolts in exhaust pipe (Optional but recommended).
11. PTO's 3 point hitches and hydraulics (Optional).
12. Hitch Height
  - a.) 20-inch maximum not less than 18 inches behind axle.
13. No lowered front axles.
